

Confidentiality

Everyone associated with The Loft has the right to privacy in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993. All personal information will be managed with care and respect in line with the Information Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act Codes of Practice and the Code of Health and Disability Services Consumers' Rights. You have the right to request to view any information held about you by any of the individual agencies at The Loft at any time. To do this, contact The Loft Office Manager and let them know which agency you have been working with, and they will organise a date and time for you to view this information.

Your information is held securely. Your information may be used to help us improve The Loft's services and identify any new services that might be helpful at The Loft. Whenever your information is used to help in this way, it is always anonymised so that you cannot be identified in any way. This means that any information that could identify you, such as your name and address, is always removed.

Your name is not attached to any statistical information and cannot in any way identify you.

If you are happy for us to use your anonymised information to help us improve The Loft's services please tick the statement below. This may include sharing your anonymised information with external researchers.

The Loft cares about your and other people's safety.
